Hours: Lafayette office has Options Counselors on call daily from 8:00 – 4:30. The Williamsport office does not have regular hours as it is the home base for Options Counselors and Case Managers who are often out of the office working with clients.

Comprehensive Service Description:

- Information and Referral Services daily through the Lafayette office for persons with aging or disability-related questions or needs. We maintain a database of community resources in Fountain and Warren counties and other areas to assist

you as well as listings of resources. All screenings and referrals for Area IV funded services are done through the Lafayette office;

- Home delivered meals – depending on your location; and hot noon meals or frozen meals through the senior centers;
- Pre-admission screening to enter nursing facilities – must contact the Lafayette office for a referral to this service. Must meet physical or cognitive disability requirements – an assessment will be done.
- Home Health Services are designed to help people remain in their homes rather than enter a nursing home. These services are funded through Federal and State monies and require disability and financial assessments to determine eligibility.
 - Funding sources include:
 - Aged and Disabled Medicaid Waiver (any age with many disabilities), must meet income and asset requirements;
 - CHOICE funding for persons of any age with many disabilities, may have a co-pay if income is over 150% poverty level;
 - Social Services Block Grant/TXX for persons over 60 or those under age 60 with disability, income under 300%;
 - Title III of Older American’s Act for persons over age 60, no income restrictions.
 - This assessment is originally done through the Lafayette office. However, the Options Counselor who comes to the home to assess you and have you sign an application for services is based out of the Williamsport office once a referral is made from the Lafayette office. And the long-term care Case Manager who will continue to help you with services once you are approved is also based out of the Williamsport office.
- Public Transportation – (no age limit or disability required) is offered through the REACH OUT Community Van for the towns of Hillsboro, Newtown, Wallace & Mellott and surrounding areas by calling 765-798-2815 Janet Keeling; an
- public transportation (no age limit or disability required) is offered through Boswell Area Transit Van (BAT VAN) by calling 765-869-4350 (Senior Center) or 765-869-5184 to serve the towns of Boswell, Oxford, Ambia, Dunnington, Chase, Tab, & Talbot;
- Special Transportation for Benton County residents 60 years & older, with mobility impairments, trips are for medical purposes only through “HOPE” Transportation Program by calling 765-404-1174 Kim Bowley and leaving a message, she checks her messages daily. Please give at least 48 hours notice;
- The Family Caregiver Program assists caregivers of older and/or disabled persons by offering information, education, support groups, and respite and supplemental services to lessen the stress on a caregiver;
- SHIP (Senior Health Insurance Program – Indiana) counseling for Medicare;
- Private Pay Care Coordinator to assist persons age 55 and older who are able to pay for someone to assist them with finding and coordinating the services they need to remain independent;
- Wellness Classes and Activities: a) EnhanceFitness – a 6 week course for older persons. Call to see if it is being offered in your area; b) Matter of Balance classes to help prevent falls – call to see if it is being offered in your area; c) Chronic

Disease Self-Management – a 6-week course designed to help persons with chronic diseases; d) Senior Games – held in Tippecanoe County – but you are welcome to participate. Held in June every year; e) Wacky Wednesdays at the Movies – for \$1 you can attend a movie and receive a snack – held in Lafayette movie theater.

SERVICES AVAILABLE: Child-centered, family-focused prevention and intervention services are provided to families in Benton, Carroll, Clinton, Fountain, Tippecanoe, Warren and White counties. Services are designed to overcome the risk factors associated with children abuse and neglect, education and strengthen families. Services are provided through the lens of child safety with an emphasis on the family as a whole and emphasize partnering with families to meet their individual needs. Programs include, **Community Partners**, a free and voluntary prevention program for parents or caregivers who are interested in strengthening their family and keeping their children safe and thriving.

BAUER FAMILY RESOURCES (CONTINUED)

Community Partners is a short-term program and can assist with: referral services for counseling, housing, food and clothing assistance, employment and other social services; financial assistance for counseling and short-term, emergency problems; goal setting through case management in the home or at a neighborhood location most convenient to the family. Bauer's **Safe Sleep Program** provides resources and education about safe sleep, as well as information on how to receive assistance in obtaining a crib. Program criteria eligibility includes: Mothers must be pregnant and within 4 weeks of the expected due date; the caregiver must attend a Safe Sleep educational training session; the caregiver currently has no available resources to procure one of their own; The parent/caregiver does not have a safe sleep environment available for the infant; the infant in need of a safe sleep environment is less than 1 year of age. Eligibility is not based on financial prerequisites. Providing services to families in Benton, Carroll, Clinton, Fountain, Tippecanoe, Warren and White counties. Referrals for case management, therapy, visitation and Fatherhood services are for clients who are referred by the Department of Child Services only.

Breaking New Ground Scholarship Fund offers financial support to undergraduate and graduate students in the School of Agriculture. Applicants must be full-time students and have a physical disability that seriously impairs any major life function. Services available to any resident of a rural community with a physical disability, caregivers of people with disabilities, or organizations seeking increased accessibility.
